### ARCOLA MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1

    - v. hardscape and landscape to serve Post Oak Pointe, Sections 1, 3, 4, and 5; and
    - vi. lift station No. 1 to serve the Reverie Ranch development;
  - e. permits, deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, and utility commitment letters; and
  - f. Utility Conveyance and Security Agreement;
