


NOTICE OF MEETING

ARCOLA MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1

The Board of Directors (“Board”) of Arcola Municipal Management District No. 1 (“District”) will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **Wednesday, January 14, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., at The Muller Law Group, PLLC, 202 Century Square Boulevard, Sugar Land, Texas 77478** to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

 - d. approval of pay estimates and change orders and acceptance of projects, as appropriate, for construction of projects in the service area, including:
 - i. City of Arcola Lift Station No. 1 – replacement;
 - ii. City of Arcola Lift Station No. 2 Force Main;
 - iii. hardscape and landscape to serve Post Oak Pointe, Sections 1, 3, 4, and 5;
 - iv. lift station No. 1 to serve the Reverie Ranch development;
 - v. Reverie Ranch Detention-Phase 1;
 - vi. Water Plant Rehab-Phase 2;
 - vii. offsite utilities to serve the Reverie Ranch development; and
 - viii. Reverie Ranch Section 1.
 - e. permits, deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, and utility commitment letters;
 - f. Utility Conveyance and Security Agreement; and
 - g. bond matters, including ratification of Resolution Authorizing Application to the TCEQ for Approval of Project and Bonds.

10. Park matters
11. Update and action on matters related to Reinvestment Zone Number 1, City of Arcola, Texas.
